1. Mission

To facilitate our Secondary 1 students' smooth transition to an English learning environment, S1 English Bridging Programme is organized for them before their new school year. "Life Building Scheme" and "Leader In Me" subject are implemented in junior forms. They help develop students' leadership as well as self-management ability. In senior forms, students are required to study 4 core subjects including English, Chinese, Mathematics and Citizenship and Social Development, and to take 3 out of 11 elective subjects including Chinese Literature, Chinese History, Economics, Geography, History, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Information & Communication Technology, Business, Accounting & Financial Studies and Visual Arts. In addition to the above subjects, students may choose to study Mathematics Extended Part (Module 1 or 2), Applied Learning, Other Language (Japanese Language) and other electives offered by the Network Schools in Tai Po.

4. Extra-curricular Activities

Extra-curricular activities have a positive influence in the development of personal interest, character, social networks and interpersonal skills. It is counted as a major element of our school education. The extra-curricular clubs of our school fall into 4 categories:
